

**BY-LAWS  
OF  
TOWN OF NORTH HERO PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE**

**1. Identify**

- 1.1 These are the by-laws of the Town of North Hero Parks and Recreation Committee.
- 1.2 The fiscal year of the committee shall be from July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30.

**2. Committee Members**

- 2.1 The number of committee members shall be nine as elected by the legal voters of the town
- 2.2 Members shall serve three-year terms and the three members shall be elected each year.
- 2.3 The Selectboard shall appoint members to vacancies to fill unexpired terms.

**3. Meetings of the Committee**

- 3.1 Meetings shall be held monthly unless otherwise directed by the Chairperson.
- 3.2 A majority of committee members attending a meeting shall constitute a quorum, for the transaction of business.

**4. Officers**

- 4.1 The officers of the committee shall be a Chairperson, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.
- 4.2 The officers of the committee will be elected annually at the monthly meeting after town meeting.

**5. Compensation**

- 5.1 No Salary of compensation will be paid to any member of the committee

**6. Reports to the Town of North Hero**

- 6.1 The Chairperson of the committee will report periodically to the Selectboard on Committee activities and committee expenditures.
- 6.2 A summary report of the committee activities will be included in the Annual Town Report as a report to the legal voters of the Town of North Hero.

**7. Committee Responsibilities**

- 7.1 The committee will be responsible, under the direction of the Selectboard, for the Planning, maintenance, rules and regulation, and activities at the two town parks at Camp Ingalls and Pelots Point.
- 7.2 The committee will also be charged with making recommendations to the community for the acquisition of the other properties to serve the recreational needs of the community in the future.
