Reduced Speed Limit, US-2, North Hero

Public Comment Opportunity

A trial reduced speed limit along US-2 through the village of North Hero is being proposed in advance of the 2019 summer season, which will be evaluated by VTrans Traffic Operations for its effectiveness and impact on safety. If found to be appropriate and effective, we will recommend to the Traffic Committee that the seasonal speed limit be made permanent.

We will forward this proposal to the Vermont Traffic Committee, who makes the final decision on implanting the trial reduced speed limit. This topic will be on the agenda of the next Traffic Committee meeting on Thursday April 25, 2019 at 10:00 am in the VTrans Board Room on the 5th floor of the National Life Building in Montpelier.

Please attend if you wish to present testimony on behalf of the town. If members of the public are unable to attend but would still like to participate, please let me know and we can make arrangements for a call-in. We encourage the town to notify local stakeholders of the opportunity to participate in this meeting.
