**Pre-Election & Election Day
Political Sign & Polling Place Policy**

Campaign Signs or Literature:

- No placement of campaign signs is allowed, at any time, on public or school property owned by the Town or School District of North Hero. However, any person can park a car, van or truck in a legal parking space with a political sign displayed in the vicinity of the polling place.
- No political literature, buttons or other political material can be displayed inside the polling place. However, any voter may bring a small brochure, card or paper into the voting booth to assist in casting his/her votes.

Campaigning Outside of Polling Place:

- Candidates or political activists can stand in the designated area(s) outside of the Town Office polling place on the day of the election and hold a sign, hand out brochures or "palm cards" to voters so long as they do not hinder or impede the progress of voters going into and out of the polling place. (17 VSA§2508)

Exit polls or surveys:


- Exit polls or surveys can be done outside of the polling place so long as the voter voluntarily offers to participate and the persons conducting the polls or surveys do not hinder or impede the progress of voters going into and out of the polling place. (17 VSA§2508)
- No person (not even town officials) is allowed to distribute surveys or questionnaires inside the polling place.


